WELCOME TO CRCCS

CRCCS is a specialty center offering a variety of programs and services for dog owners, shelters, veterinarians, dog trainers, and facilities that provide care for animals. Our services cater to special needs dogs, serious behavior cases, and dogs who have been to multiple training centers without success. We offer a variety of behavior-based programs and services geared to reduce euthanasia rates, reduce shelter return rates, educate owners, and keep dogs in homes.

Once you are in the family, your dog is considered an alumni and can be approved for other services such as sleepovers; giving them a safe and enriching place to stay overnight with experienced staff while you travel. Most of the dogs in our care are not welcome at other facilities. Here, you are family and welcomed with open arms.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

We all do more for those we trust and respect. Dogs are no different. If training isn't working, you've come to the right place. At CRCCS, we specialize in behavior, a very different approach than training. The most respectful way to communicate to any being, human or canine, is to communicate to them on their level. Through respectful communication, not with force or constant treats, we help dogs overcome and learn new ways of doing things. Just like us, they are all individuals. What works for one dog may not work for another. Our behavior-based training approach gets to the root cause of the issue so you and your canine companion can strengthen your relationship and get more out of life!



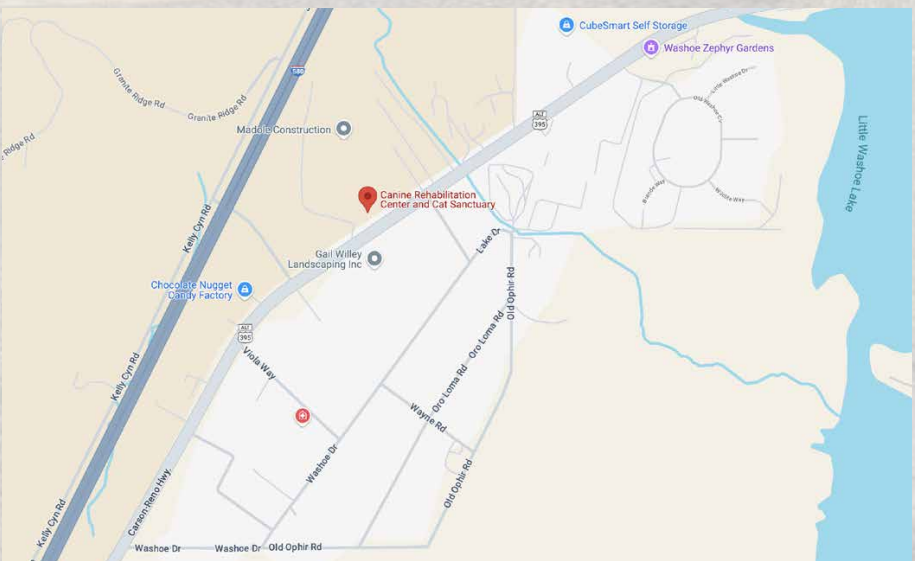
OUR FACILITY

The CRCCS facility offers close access to Davis Creek Park, Washoe Lake State Park, Timberline and Galena trails, and many more peaceful “off the beaten path” walking trails. In addition, we have a nature path gently weaving through our property and various engagement activities along the way.

Our campus is located in Washoe Valley, just 6 short miles south of Reno, Nevada and within minutes of Lake Tahoe and Carson City. We have 5.2 acres of land and are surrounded by acres of vacant land that we utilize all day as we get out and explore with the dogs. We have 12,000 sq. ft of indoor facility space as well as a 1900 sq ft training house; both offering a safe haven for dogs requiring more special needs care.

We are building a campus including a behavioral center, cat cottage, outdoor amphitheater and much more.

Canine Rehabilitation Center & Cat Sanctuary is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit and our mission is to inspire, educate, and motivate the human spirit, as well as save, nurture, and love the canine spirit—bringing the two together to change the way the world views, rescues, and places homeless dogs and cats.





BEHAVIOR CONSULTATION | \$500

IN-HOME BEHAVIOR CONSULTATION | \$650

Our behavior consultation is always such an eye-opening experience for dog owners and trainers. You're guaranteed to hear and learn things you have never heard before. This is a full, information-packed, one-on-one consultation (with some demonstrations) with you, your dog, and the behaviorist. You will walk away with an incredible amount of insight and information regarding your dog's behavior. Each behavior consultation is geared toward you and your dog's specific needs. You will take this information and start affecting results the very next day. We don't ask you to go out and "train" every day. This is a very different approach. Behavior is a lifestyle.

The behavior consultation price includes a 3 to 3.5 hour in-person consultation, paperwork, and a 75 minute in person follow up session customized to the needs of the dog.





ASSESSMENTS

These are all hands-on working sessions/assessments, in the real world. It is unfair and unethical to label or assess any dog unless we've taken the time to get to know them, learn them, work with them, and build a trusting relationship with them. We will work with your dog and introduce them to different stimuli, giving us the opportunity to properly assess their individual cognitive skill-set, their ability to read situations and make proper threat assessments, their ability to communicate (send and receive information), and to learn what is really driving the behavior. As behaviorists, our goal is to identify the "root cause." No judgments or labels.





QUICK ASSESSMENT | ONE DAY \$400

A one day assessment which includes two hours of our behaviorist working with your dog, exposing him/her to different people/dogs/stimuli and then 90 minutes with the owner. This assessment is used to determine dog aggression vs dog reactivity, getting a better understanding of character and temperament, intensity and intent. As well, we will pinpoint the dogs preferences and communication skill-set with other dogs, determining where they are at in their cognitive abilities.

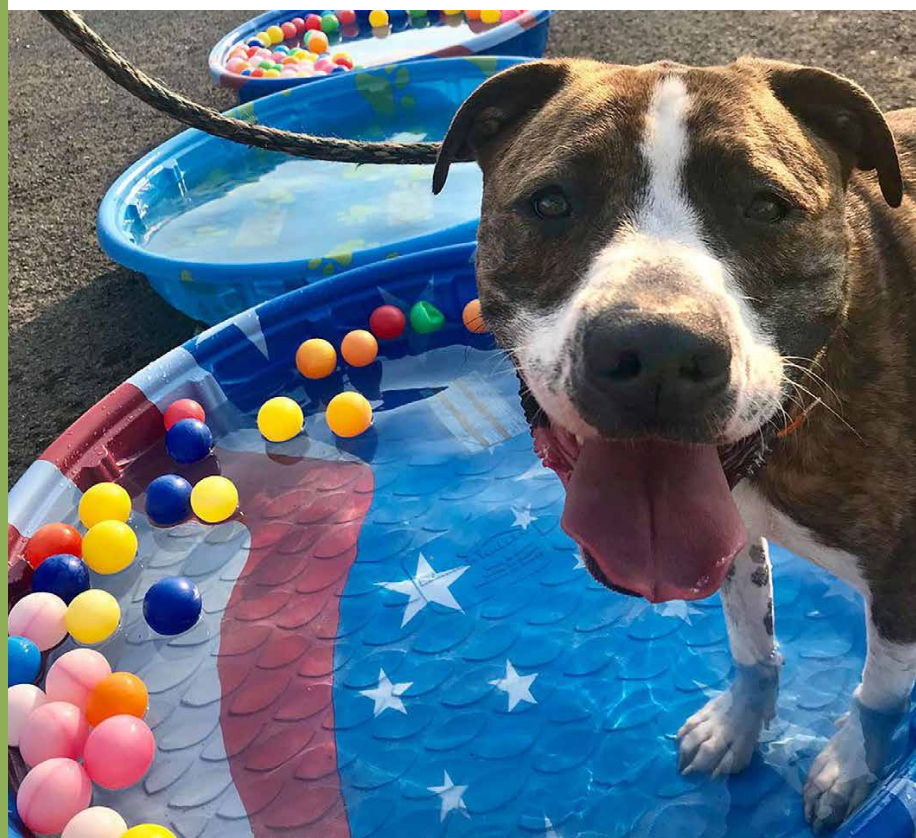
This information gives us insight into the intensity and intent of the animal. Quick assessments are often used when a new dog comes into the family, for landlords, rescue groups or shelters needing evaluations, or for those looking to start behavior training after failed attempts at other facilities and don't know where to start.





FORMAL DOG ASSESSMENTS THREE DIFFERENT DAYS \$600

The behaviorist will work with your dog on three different days, each day consists of a 90 minute working session with the dog . At the end of the 3 working sessions, you will meet with the behaviorist for 90 minutes of education/consultation as to what your dog will need moving forward. Formal assessments are often used for shelters, rescue groups, or new adopters that see behaviors and need help identifying what they are working with and/or a plan of approach (with training or at home moving forward).





ONE-ON-ONE SESSIONS

\$200

Our one-on-one sessions are as real-world and educational as it gets. This is a 90 minute hands-on coaching session out on the trails, in a real world setting with you, your dog, our behaviorist and an assistant. These sessions are used for a variety of circumstances- whether you just want to be able to walk your dog again, or maybe you need guidance on how to help your dog overcome real world stimulus that leads to unwanted behaviors such as fear or reactivity. Many of our clients come back over and over for these sessions. As you improve your skill set and understanding of how to read your dog, these sessions become quite comforting for owners, giving them a reset while helping keep their dog on track.

INTENSIVE TRAINING | \$150

Our Intensive Training sessions are reserved for canines working to overcome more serious behavior challenges.

These two 45-minute sessions are more intense and target specific behaviors such as insecurity, fear, reactivity, resource guarding and more.

Use for closing out initial behavior modification package or starting lower intensity behaviors. Includes eight Intensive Training Days and one one-on-one session.

Daycamp Package (IT Graduates Only)

12 Pack | \$500 (\$100 savings)

6 Pack | \$275 (\$25 savings)

Six separate Daycamp days. This package is for Intensive Training graduates to continue their behavior training when it is still needed but not at an Intensive Training level. We are there to help out with anything that arises for owners. This is about positive structured socialization and working on life skills.

SLEEPOVER PROGRAM

Whatever it is that requires you to travel, our Sleepover Program provides overnight support for dogs who might need more individualized attention. Each pup (or family of pups!) gets their own private condo specifically selected for their needs. Throughout the day, your dog(s) will enjoy a minimum of three fun, structured, and engaging outings. Your pup will receive their regular meals and any medications instructed by you.

When relaxing in their room, every dog is treated to aromatherapy with calming doTERRA essential oils while they luxuriate on their cozy blankets and bed, keeping them comfortable and pampered between play. Calming lullabies are played at night and every dog has exposure to a night light.

CRCCS also offers socialization (if requested), foundation training, and loose leash walking. Your dog will have an opportunity to engage in activities such as our confidence course, ramps, slides, tree stump climbing, long hikes, leisurely walks, or ball. You tell us what they'll enjoy and our team is on it!

PRICING

Standard Rate Per Dog: **\$45/night**

Per Dog Under 25 lbs: **\$40/night**

WHAT TO BRING?

- **Vaccination records**, including Bordetella, Distemper/Parvo, and Rabies. Influenza is strongly recommended but not required.
- **Any current medications**
- **Food and Feeding instructions**
- **The remaining balance**

SLEEPOVER POLICIES

All services require a **50% DEPOSIT** at the time of scheduling. After a 24 hour courtesy hold, you will be removed from the calendar. All deposits are transferable but non-refundable.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to the high demand and limited space, we require a minimum of **48 hour notice** for any canceled reservations so that we may offer the space to a dog on our waiting list. Your deposit can be transferred to another reservation or service, but remains non-refundable.
